ASSISTANT – Assist docents during the classroom project with set up, clean up, and students. You do not have to attend the workshop or teach the projects. Just be there to help!

MATERIALS PREP – Prepare materials as needed for a project. This may entail cutting, sorting, and/or basic preparation, and can be done outside of school hours in your home.
